

## Simple Steps to make Fringe



First Hoop Your item to be embroidered.

Next run the complete design.



At different places in the design you will be stitching long satin stitches as shown by green thread.



Next take the hoop off of the machine. Flip the design over.

I leave my design on the hoop until complete.

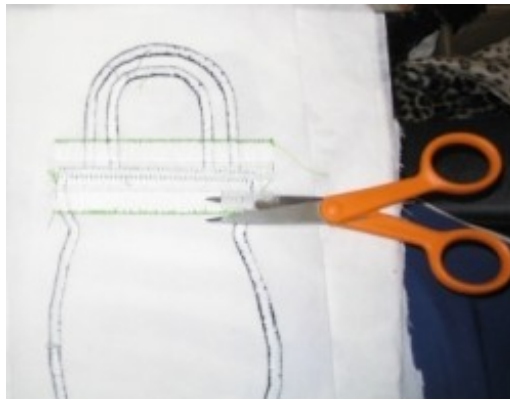
You will see long white bobbin thread in the area of the satin stitches,  
(there will be a jpeg with the clip area in each Band To Bow Design File).

Slide the scissors under the area indicated in the instructions and clip the bobbin thread.

There is always a "tack down" stitch to hold down the thread.

On this design it is right in the center as pictured. Do not clip the tack down stitch.

Only clip the long bobbin area.



Now turn the design back over with the front of the design facing you and gently pull the loose thread up. I use scissors or a pair of tweezers and slide right under the area.



Once all of the thread has been pulled up, take your finger and slightly fluff the fringed area. The fringed area will have bobbin thread pieces in the design simply shake the design and the excess bobbin thread will fall out.

At this point I flip it back over and trim off the excess bobbin thread up to the "tack down" stitch.

**\*\*Note Do Not Clip the "Tack Down" stitch.**

The finished product is now complete.
